

## London Festival of Architecture

The Museum of Architecture has commissioned three giant sandcastles by contemporary architects located across the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea. The summer installations are created as part of the inTransit Festival and the London Festival of Architecture (LFA), with designs responding to this year's LFA theme of 'memory', as well as that of 'island life' set by the InTransit festival.

The Square's sandcastle is created by Nex Architecture, who have been inspired by the remarkable history of Sir Hans Sloane - whose statue is located at Duke of York Square. Over the course of his lifetime he amassed a vast collection of natural specimens. Nex has designed a large shell in sand that offers an x-ray view through the outer surface in order to reveal the structure within.


