Movies on the River

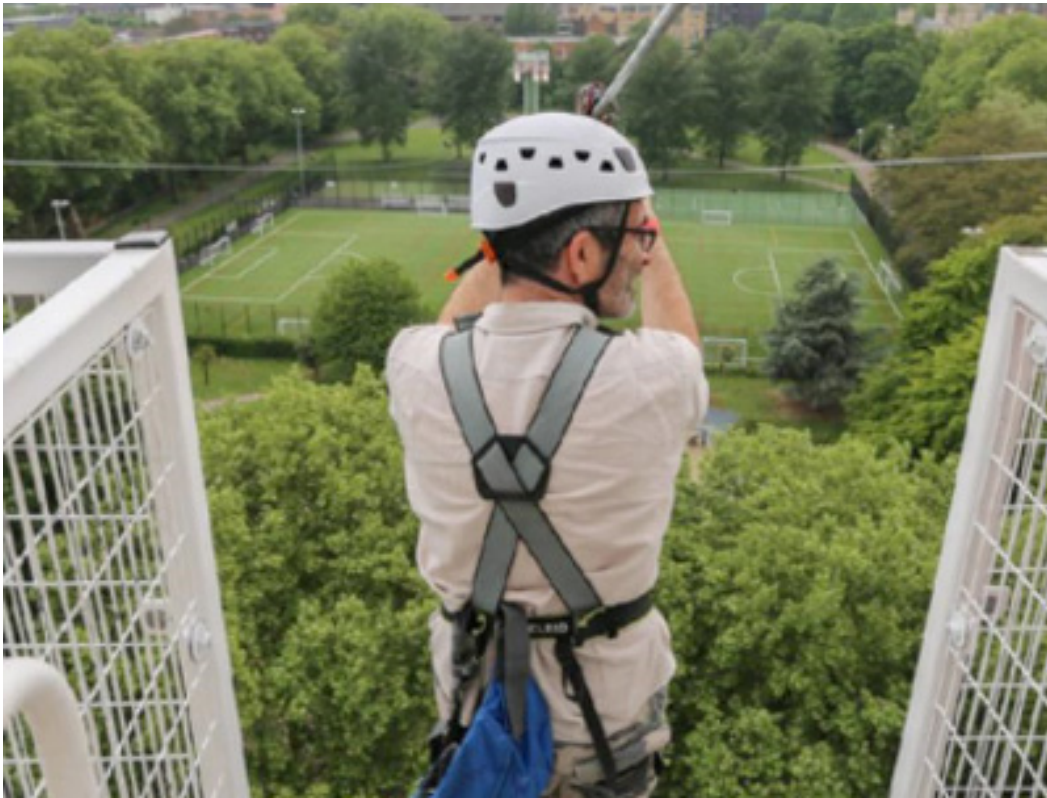
