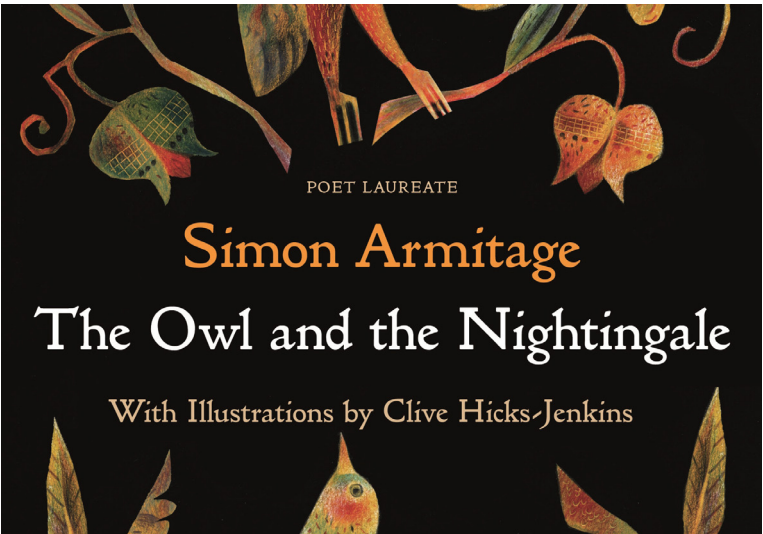


A Soldier's Life in the 18th Century

Pavilion Road

Pavilion Road, London SW1X

Considered by critics as one of the finest foodie spots in the world, Chelsea's artisan quarter Pavilion Road is home to restaurants and food shops, cafes and bars aplenty to whet your appetite, with seating spilling out on to the street. From Granger & Co's hotcakes to seafood at The Sea The Sea, perhaps a latte-to-go from the Roasting Party or even a tipple (or two) from Mother Vine; a table al fresco on our mews guarantees a day well-spent.

Duke of York Square

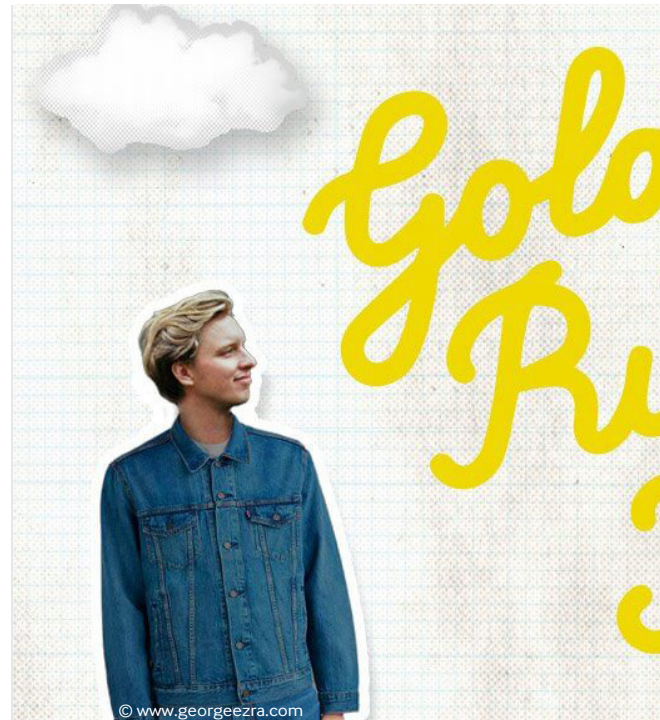

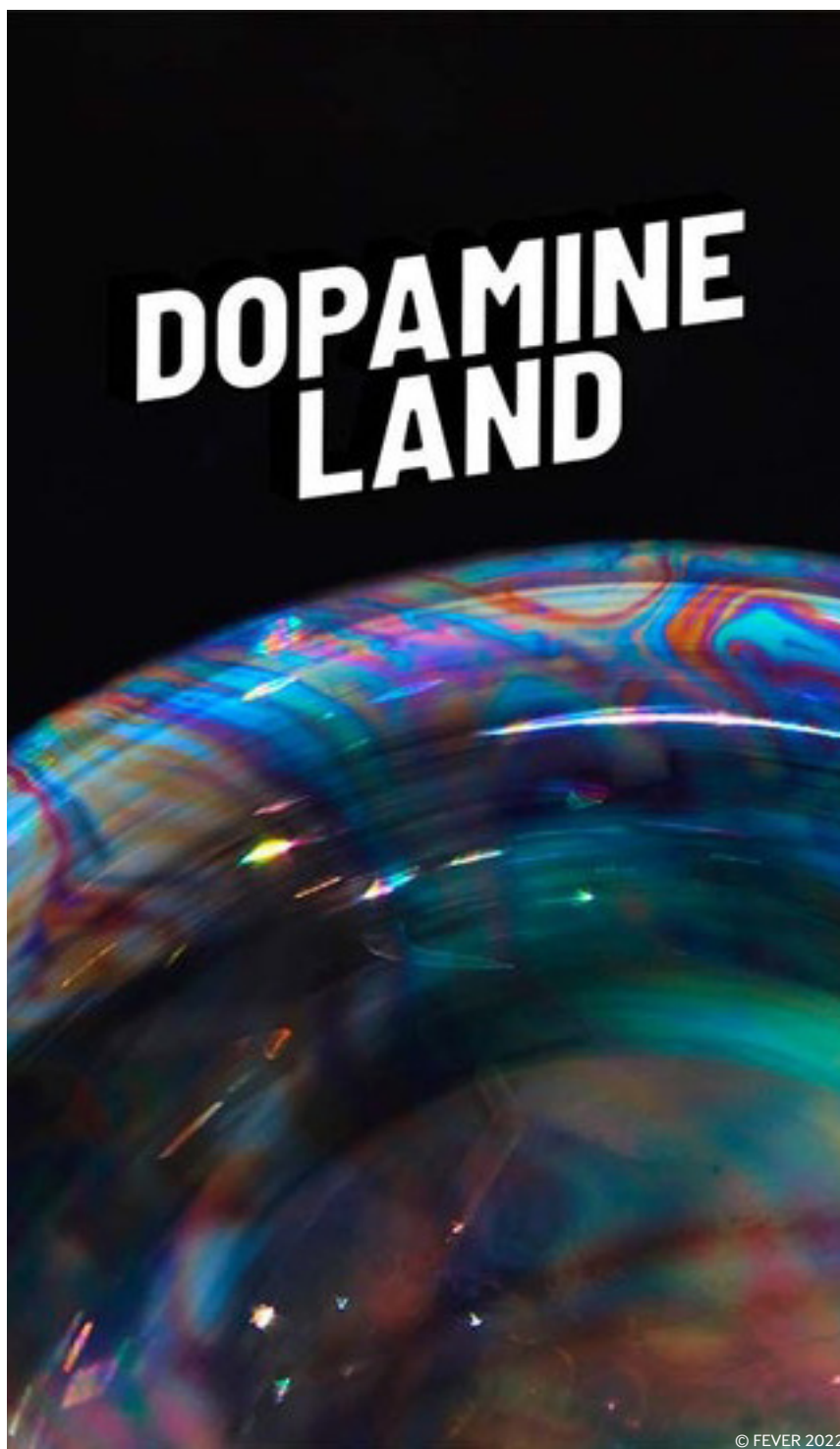
