And for those grabbing a quick bite from the bar menu, the Moroccan spiced flatbread with hummus and butter leaves is the perfect accompaniment to glass of rosé on the terrace with friends.

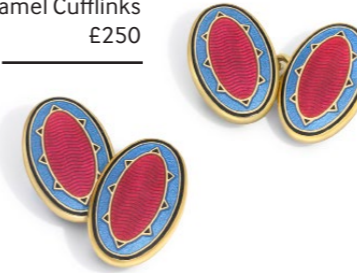

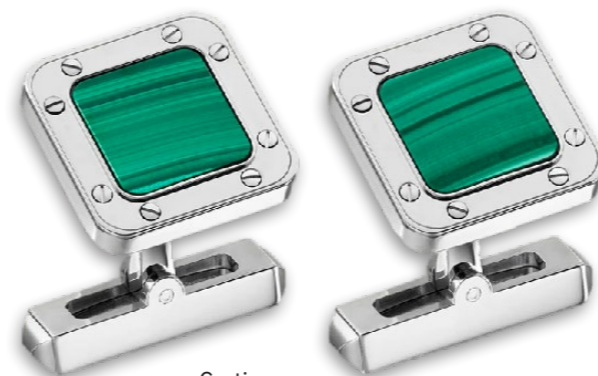

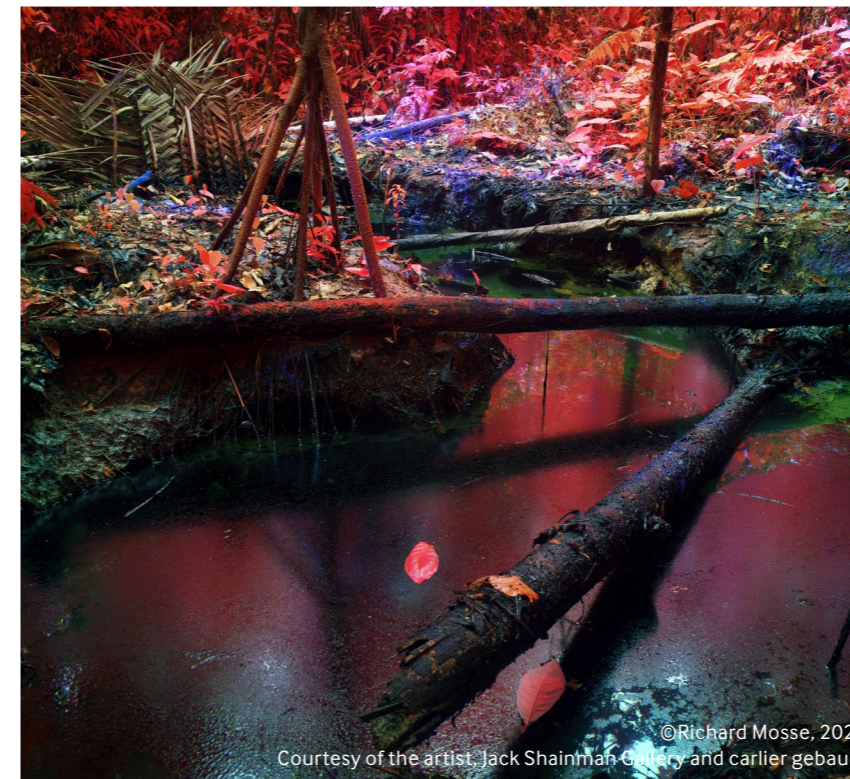
