Chelsea's Best Bakeries

National Baking Week falls from 14 - 20 October and fortunately, Chelsea is a goldmine for bakeries. Here's where to find perfectly-proved sourdough, fabulously-flaked pastry and artisanal creations across the neighbourhood.

Birley Bakery

28-30 Cale Street, London, SW3 3QU

Inspired by the traditional boulangeries-pâtisseries of France, the Birley Bakery is the latest venture by Robin Birley, of 5 Hertford Street. With creations that, rumour has it, took five years to perfect, as well as contemporary twists on classics, this is a haven for pastry perfection. It's a feast for the eyes too, with whimsical murals hand painted by artist Lizzi Porter that can also be found on the covetable boxes for the bakery's hand-made chocolates. Exquisite creations include mille-feuille, orange and cinnamon madeleines, and the French classic, the Paris-Brest, whilst the simple croissant is their best seller. If it's good enough for Beyonce, then it's good enough for us.

If you're looking for a showstopping bake, Peggy Porschen's pink parlour is the place to visit. Step through the seasonally adorned arches and the pastel pink to discover Peggy's dreamy world and love for cakes and cookies, with a host of party cakes and cupcakes adorned in roses, sparkles, rainbows and even mermaid tails. Heralded by Vanity Fair as 'the best cupcakes in the world', the 'Raspberry Jammie Dodger Cupcake' is one of their best sellers and for reassurance, dietaries are considered where flavour definitely isn't compromised.





Buns from Home

Deliciously decadent, these are possibly London's best Cinnamon Buns. Buns from Home was founded by Barney in his mother's kitchen, eager to please his neighbourhoods during lockdown and is now one of West London's best bakeries. Each bun is handmade and at the heart of their creations is the exceptional quality butter, sourced from a dairy farm in Normandy, family-run since 1946. You can often expect queues but it's worth the wait, with traditional flavours alongside savoury creations topped with avocado and chicken, as well as dessert buns, filled with custard cream or even tiramisu.
