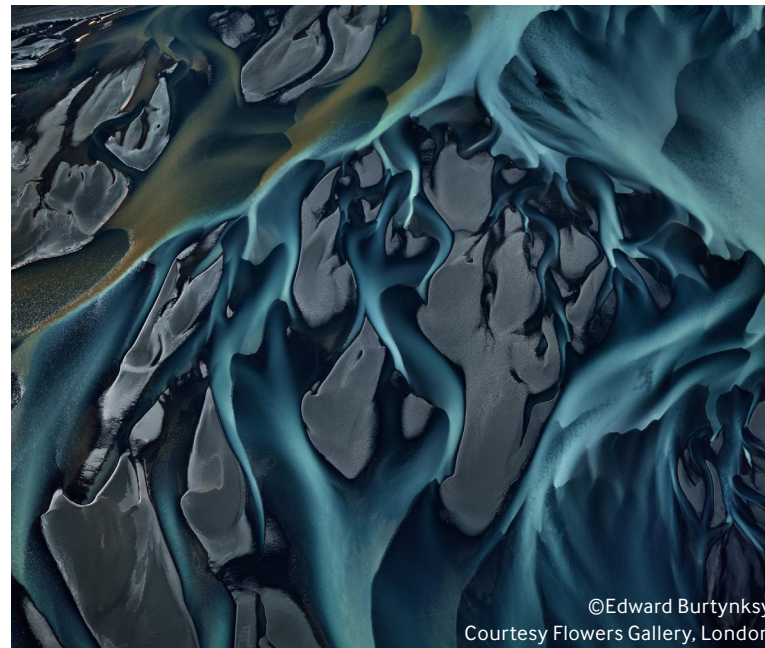

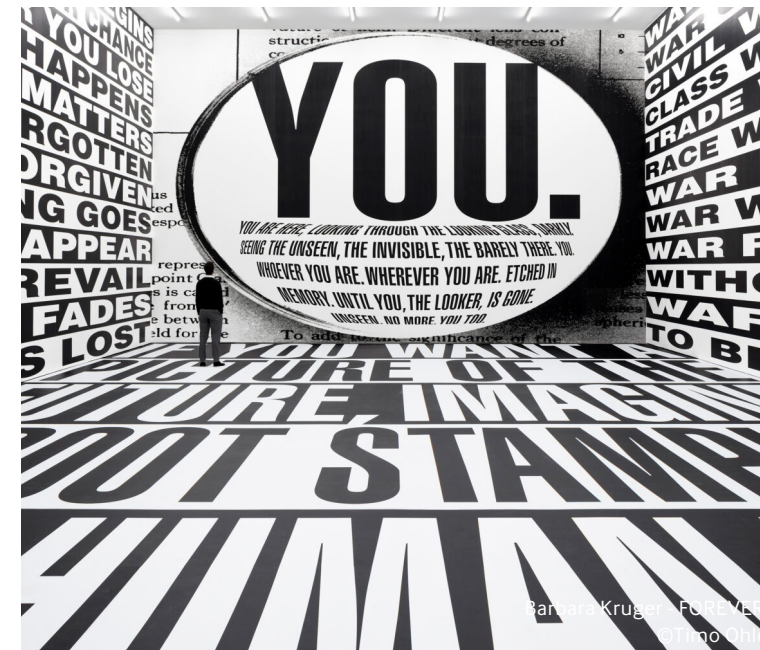
Burtynsky: Extraction/Abstraction
