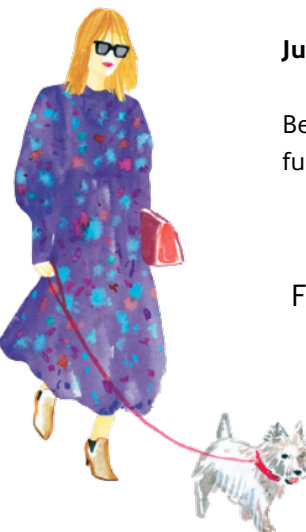

FRIEZE Comes to Sloane Street

This October, Sloane Street becomes an open-air gallery as Frieze steps beyond Regent's Park for the first time. Named the art fair's inaugural Destination Partner, the Street will stage Modern Nature, a curated display by Frieze Studios coinciding with Frieze London and Frieze Masters 2025. Works by Maya Rose Edwards, William Farr, James Jessiman, Marc Quinn and Ro Robertson will transform Chelsea's most iconic thoroughfare into a cultural promenade.

Expect the unexpected: Quinn's monumental flower forms reimaged, Robertson's casts shaped by coastal erosion, and Farr's otherworldly celestial colours. Interspersed among iconic London landmarks, these installations invite passers-by to pause, look closer, and reconsider our relationship with the natural world.

This is just the beginning. Alongside the artworks, Sloane Street's boutiques and restaurants will unveil a programme of activations inspired by the festival — details to be revealed very soon. Whether you're an art aficionado or simply curious, Sloane Street this season is more than a shopping destination — it's an evolving cultural stage.

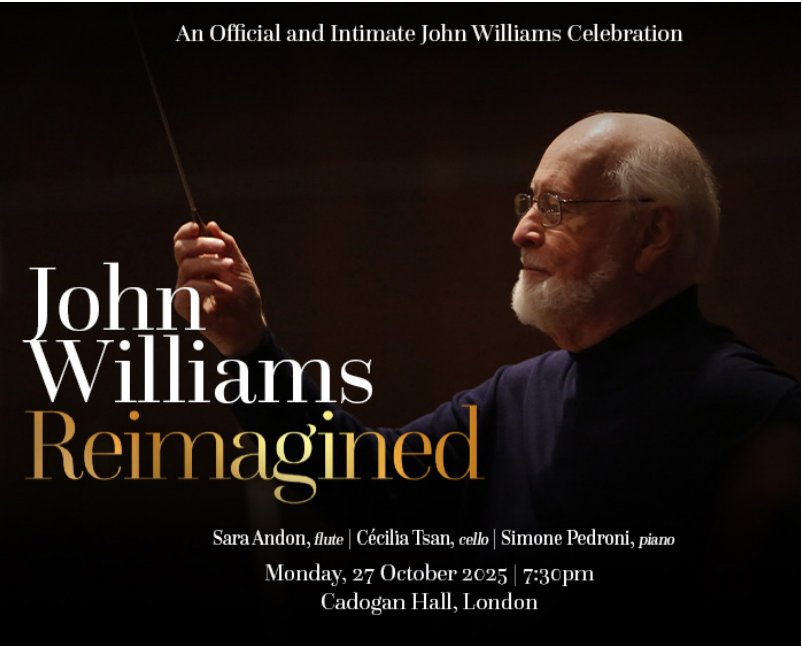

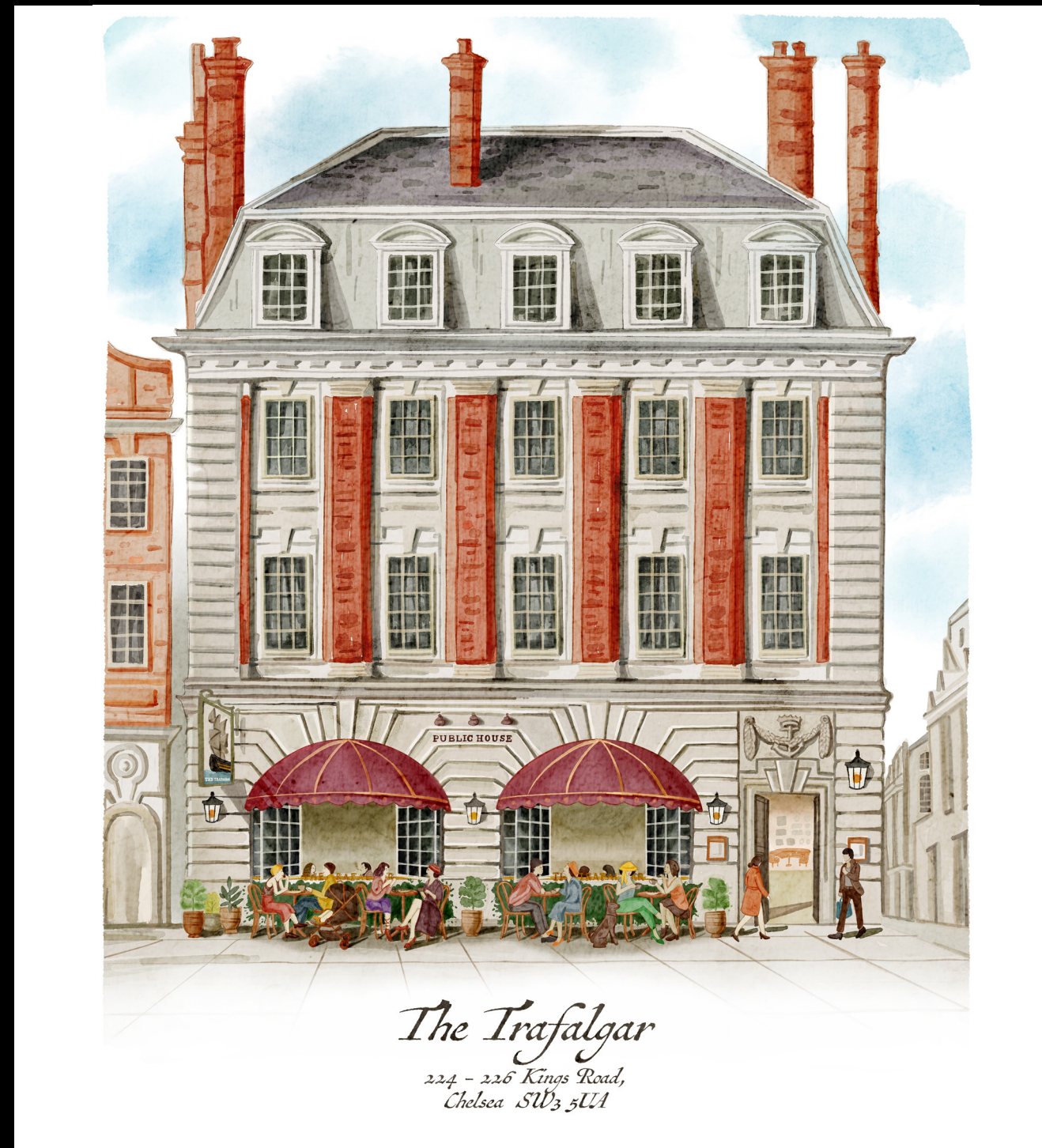
