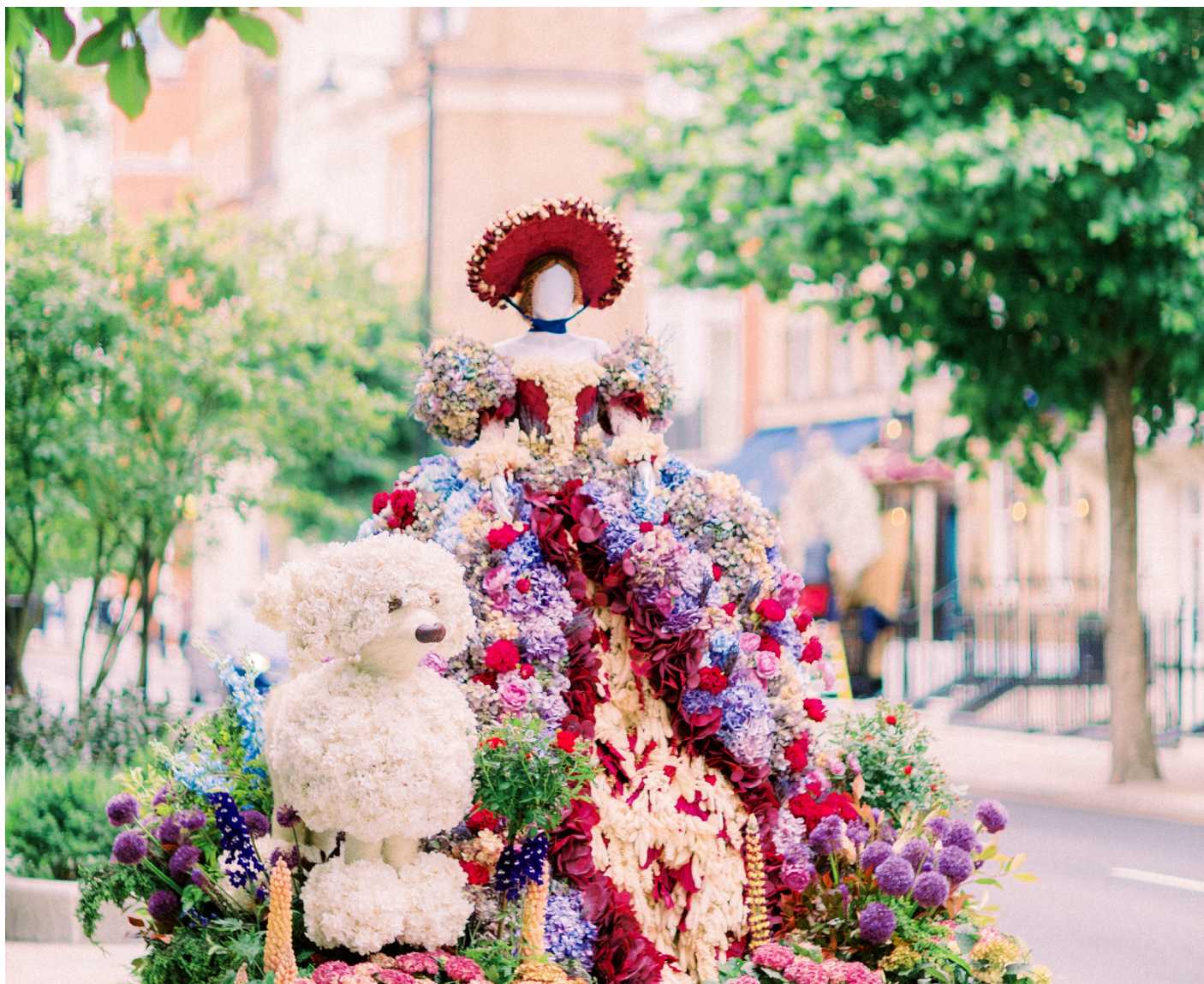

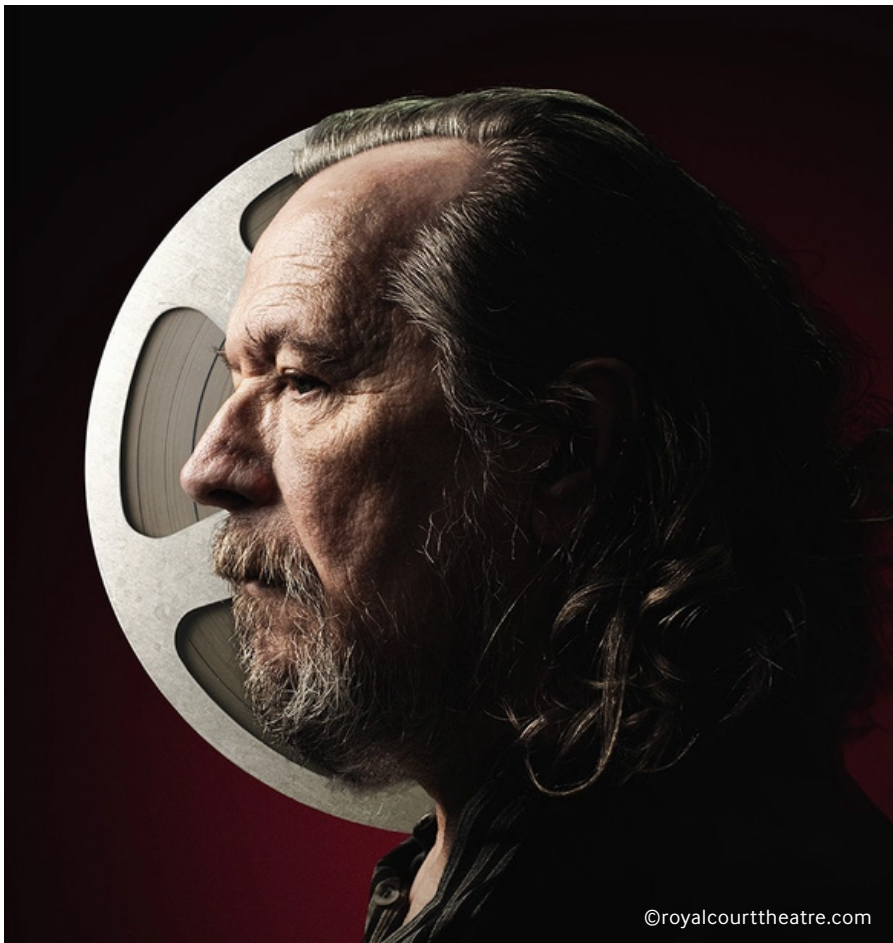

The Ivy

Lush, tucked away and especially atmospheric, The Ivy's hidden garden terrace is the perfect spot to slip off King's Road and linger during Chelsea in Bloom. The spring menu keeps things fresh and seasonal, with highlights like zucchini fritti with lemon, chilli and mint yoghurt and half roast chicken with asparagus spears, the perfect pause right in the heart of Chelsea

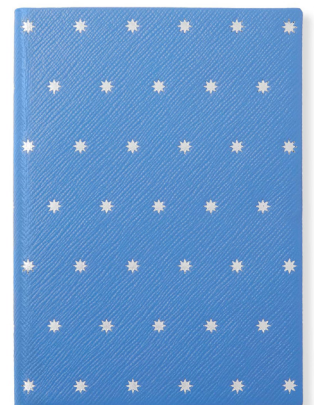
